# Congress of Vienna 

Choreography by John Hertz Transcription by Tom Hill, Last updated 2023-10-01

The dance starts with the introduction, then parts A and B repeat, and then the music ends with a part A. The number of As and Bs is up to the band. The original music is ABABABABA, which is 8 minutes and 10 seconds. Most commonly played now are ABABA or ABABABA.

## Introduction

| Intro <br> 4 Measures | Face your partner one measure one. Acknowledge/smile at your partner on <br> measure two. Bow or Curtsy during measure three, turn to face line of dance <br> during four. |

Part A

| Open Waltz <br> 4Measurs | During measure four, return to closed dance position for rotary waltz. <br> Don't swing your free hand wildly. It should be beside you, not behind you. |

| Rotary Waltz <br> 10 Measures | During measure ten, release the lady to open position, side by side, facing <br> line of dance, lady on man's right. |
| Open Waltz <br> 4Measures | Remember to start each section with the correct foot (man's left, lady's <br> right). This is in opposition, man's left foot, and right hand move forward. |
| Rotary Waltz <br> 10 measures | Open Waltz <br> 8Measurs |
| Rotary Waltz <br> 8measures | On last measure, open to facing, two hand hold, ideally with the man facing <br> out. |

Part B

| Windows (wind) <br> 4Measures | Man raises right hand, lady turns $3 / 4$ turn under, to her left. Man turns $1 / 4$ turn <br> to his right to complete the window during the fourth measure. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Windows (turn) <br> 4Measurs | Both man and lady walk forward for four measures. |
| Windows (unwind) <br> 4Measurs | Take two measures to unwind, and two measures to wind the other direction. |
| Windows (turn) <br> 4Measres | Both man and lady walk forward for four measures. |
| Unwind <br> 1 Measure | Man should be facing out at this point, but it's not critical. |
| Lady to Man's Left <br> 4 Measures | Man leads lady to his left, lets go with his left, and places the lady's left <br> hand in his left. Lady walks all the way around behind him, ending on his <br> right. |
| Circle <br> 4Measures | Man walks backward, lady forward. |
| Pause <br> 1 Measure | Original choreography was a plié, but that's rarely done.. |
| Lady to Man's Right <br> 4Measres | Man leads lady back to his left. Take your time, four measures is a long time <br> to walk four feet. |
| Circle <br> 4Measurs | Man walks backward, lady forward. |
| Return to Front <br> 1 Measure | Ideally, man should be facing outward. This will leave you facing line of <br> dance after the windows. If not, use the windows to adjust your facing. |
| Windows (wind) <br> 4Measurs | See above |
| Windows (turn) <br> 4Measures | See above |
| Unwind <br> 1 Measure | Unwind to side by side, facing line of dance, to start part A. |
